Classes begin on Wednesday, February 5, at 8:00 a.m.

All fees must be paid before a student may begin registration (except for lab fees which must be paid during registration). If your fees have not been paid, begin by reporting to the Treasurer's Office and then to Station I.

As noted above, language lab and science lab fees will be collected during registration. Plan to bring enough pocket money to cover these fees. Your registration will not be complete until these fees are paid. Language lab fees are \$3 or \$4 depending on course taken, and science lab fees are \$5 or \$10 depending on course taken.

Continuing students will receive validation stickers in their registration packet. These are to be affixed to the rear of the permanent student identification card. New students will be photographed for ID cards during registration.

Registration at times other than those indicated in the above schedule (either early or late) will be allowed only in cases of dire personal hardship and only when such hardship is supported by proper documentation. Such requests may be processed through the Student Affairs Office prior to registration.
