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





Approaches and Methods

The Jumpstart Curriculum builds the key language and literacy skills children need to be ready for kindergarten. Children participate in 20 weeks of sessions, twice week, targeted to build language, per literacy, and social emotional skills. Session plans are organized in six unit themes --Family, Friends, Wind and Water, The World of Color, Shadows and Reflections, and Things That Grow.



Observe Give Classrooms and Jumpstart's Feedback. staff members provide 40+ hours of training and observe classroom teaching throughout the year to ensure quality and effectiveness.




