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



Goals

- Explore organizational infrastructure, skills, resources and motivations that aid in adoption of evidence-based cancer screening interventions (EBIs) among Latino churches in Massachusetts
- 2. Develop, implement and evaluate the relative efficacy of a Capacity-Enhancement (CE) intervention compared to a Standard Dissemination (SD) intervention in implementation of EBIs among 30 churches


