### **Driving direction**

On the map below, there are two different routes to the Campus Center indicated.

If you are coming directly from Morrissey Boulevard and the **main entrance** of the university, you should follow the **bright green** route.

If you are coming from Mount Vernon Street, you should follow the **bright turquoise route** that then turns into the green route. When you take a right off Mount Vernon near **Lot C**, you will make a **left** to continue east toward the campus center following the **green route**.

### **Parking**

The best parking lots are indicated on the map with the “**heart**” icon in pink. These parking lots vary in size, but all have the flat rate of \$6 for the entire day.

We highly recommend parking your vehicle at the Bayside Parking Lot on Mt. Vernon Street. The Bayside Lot uses Shuttle #3 to bring guests from the lot to the Athletic Center and the Campus Center. The Shuttle #3 bus stop is clearly indicated at the lot, outside the Athletic Center and the Campus Center.

If you park at Lot D, the Beacon Lot, or the Campus Center lot, you will have to walk to the Conference located in the Campus Center.

From Lot D it is only about a 5-minute walk, the Beacon Lot is about 3 minutes from the Campus Center and the Campus Center Lot only requires an elevator ride to the third floor.



## Public Transportation

UMass Boston is located on the Red Line as well as the Bus Route 8 and 16. If you are on Bus 8 or 16, you can stay on the bus until the last stop - the UMass Boston Campus Center. These two buses also stop at the JFK/UMass Station, if you get off there, you can hop on the #1 Shuttle Bus that will bring you directly to the Campus Center entrance.
