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Notes on the data in this report

The data in this report are drawn from three U.S. Cenusu Bureau datasets: the 2014 American Community Survey 1-year estimates, the 2010–2014 American Community Survey 5-year estimates, and the 2010-2014 American Community Survey 5-Year Public Use Microdata Sample (PUMS). Each are distinct data sets with different samples and estimates. The dataset used for each table and chart is indicated.

Population data from the 2010 Decennial Census may be found in the Institute for Asian American Studies report from October 2012. The American Community Survey is not intended to be used for accurate population counts.

• All income data is reported in 2014 inflation-adjusted dollars.

• Data for Chinese Americans does not include Taiwanese Americans except when drawn from the 2010-2014 American Community Survey 5-Year Public Use Microdata Sample (PUMS), as noted. Data for Chinese Americans from this source includes Taiwanese Americans for the years 2010 and 2011.

• Data in this report is for racial groups "alone" (meaning those individuals who identified themselves as being of one race only) and Asian American subgroups "alone" (meaning those individuals who identified themselves as being of one Asian American subgroup only), **except as noted**.

• Hispanics and Latinos may be of any race, and the terms are used interchangeably in this report.





Nativity and Citizenship Status for Asian Americans in Massachusetts












Educational Attainment by Race and Latino Origin for the Population 25 Years and Over in Massachusetts






Median Household Income for Selected Asian American Subgroups in Massachusetts




Per Capita Income for Selected Asian American Subgroups in Massachusetts


Family Poverty Rate for Selected Asian American Subgroups in Massachusetts

Educational Attainment for Selected Asian American Subgroups for the Population 25 Years and Over in Massachusetts





Nativity and Citizenship Status for Asian Americans in Boston








English Usage at Home and Proficiency by Race and Latino Origin for the Population 5 Years and Over in Boston



Household Income Distribution for Asian Americans in Boston




Individual Poverty Rate by Race and Latino Origin in Boston


