(Caroline heard Meredith, and her world went blank.)

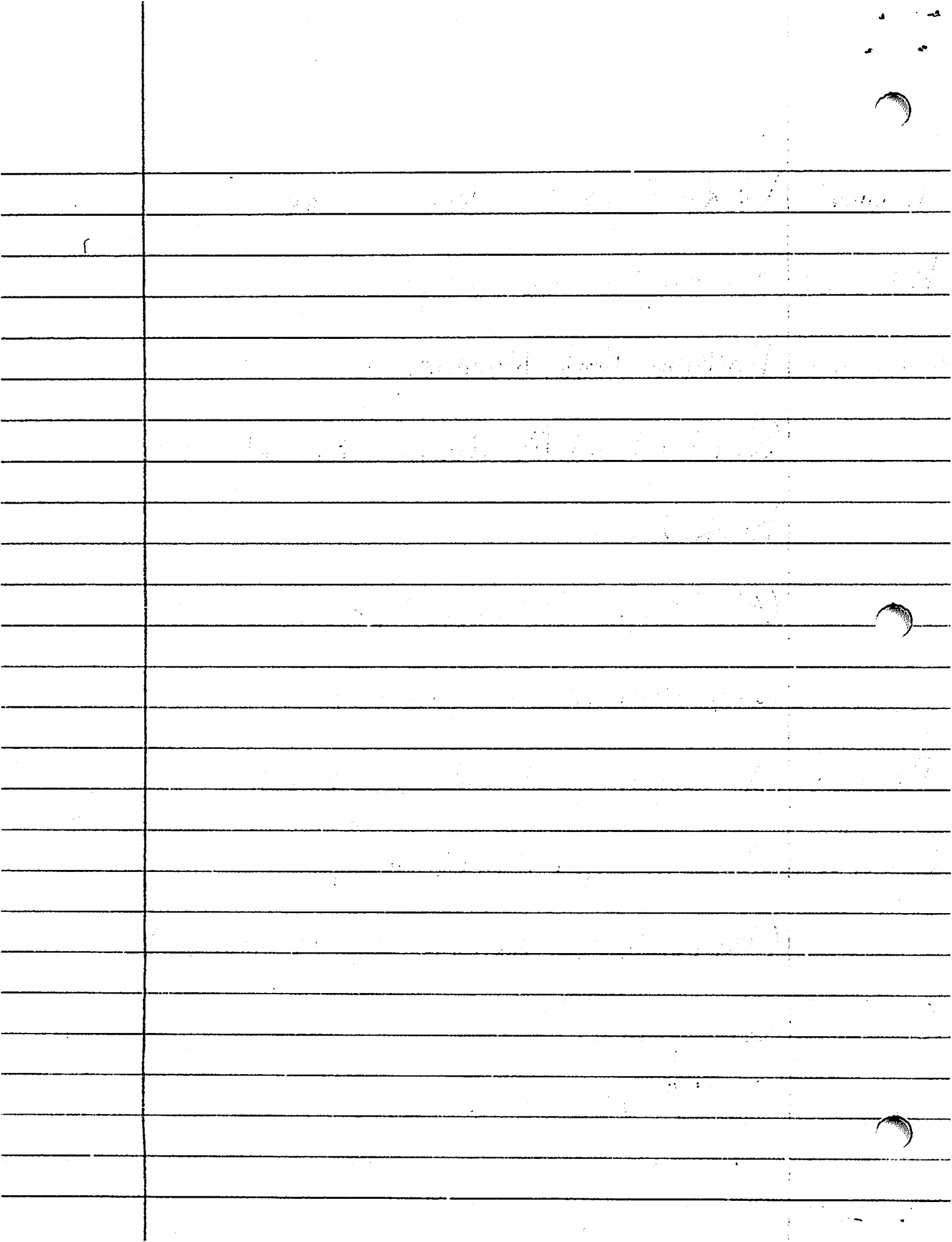
(She thought to herself "I can't be related to her their not my parents.")
